I'm glad that Dorothy is going to school - I think that I can send her \$10 a mo. and maybe more if I get the \$10 raise Congress voted on. She ought to be able to get a job as soon as she finishes school -

I got another letter from the fellow I know in Mass. He said they wanted some more dope about my radio experience. They need radio operators pretty bad but they are already overstrength~~ed~~ in men so I don't know yet if I can transfer or not.

I don't know whether I'll get my furlough or not but will know in a few days - Hope I get it because I intend to ask for a transfer next month.

Well that's all the news here - Hope everybody is O.K.
