Its been a pretty long time since I've wrote to you. I think I got a letter from you just before I left Maine - Sorry I waited so long to answer it. - I got a letter from Dorothy today postmarked Sept 30. So it seems like our mail service is sort of uncertain.

How are you getting along in High School? Dorothy said they were having trouble keeping teachers. I guess that's because they are finding better jobs elsewhere.

Well Alice, I am still ok and enjoying myself. The weather isn't so good - lots of mud but it isn't very cold yet. I don't have much to do in the way of work. We have a radio school here - I work there when I don't have anything else to do. - I still have my motorcycle but haven't used it lately because of a flat tire and muddy roads. I think I'll take it back to the States with me for a souvenir. Its a 1926 model but still runs good. -



I think I'll go to London next week and see some of the sights. Most of the fellows here have been several times but I haven't been there yet.

Guess that's about all the news from here. There's not much to write about. Write soon and let me know how everybody is getting along. Would like to hear from Bill and Russell. Dorothy said she thought Bill was in Alaska. I suppose he will have a "White Christmas". - Tell Jewell I will answer her letter soon, and tell Mama and Dad hello (I would like to have the Mo. Co. Dear Alice,

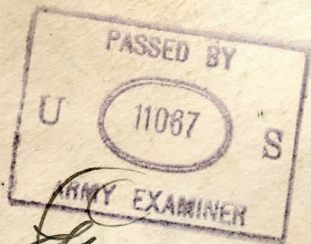
