Dear Russell,

Received your letter today and sure was glad to hear from you. How do you like your outfit? - The folks said you wanted to get in the Air Corps but I think you will get along ~~in~~ where ~~that~~ you are. - One branch is about as good as any other after you get used to it.

I don't suppose there's many boys left at Lansing by now. Nearly every time I hear from home they tell me about somebody else getting in the Army.

Well Russell I am getting along ~~in~~ over here. Our outfit just moved to a new field and I haven't been to any of the new towns yet but I was pretty well acquainted back at our other place. I don't go out much tho on account of the weather and lack of transportation.

I have been hearing from home pretty regularly - Sometimes a letter takes a long time to get here - Got one or two yesterday that was mailed the fourth of Nov.

Well, I suppose the weather is pretty cold in Ky. It hasn't been very cold here yet. - I got a letter from Bill yesterday - from the way he writes, Alaska must be a pretty nice place. I'd like to go there sometime -

There's not much I can write about here so will close - Hope you are getting along ok - You might give me some dope on what kind of work you are doing and what kind of an outfit you are in - Write soon.
