June 21, 1940

Dear Mama,

I suppose you hadn't had time to receive my last letter when you wrote Thursday. I didn't expect you to write again until I answered. Time is passing pretty fast for me. They are keeping me pretty busy. I have to see that the boys in my squad are up and dressed ~~for~~ at 5:30 every morning. ~~I have to see that~~ Also that the tent is clean and the bunks are made up. I have to get up 4:30 every morning and I don't usually get to sleep until nine or ten. I don't see how I wake up but I do.

I hope you ~~had~~ ^{had} a good trip to James town. I suppose you will be back when this letter gets there.

I told about all the news in my last letter and I can't think of any more. I haven't taken any pictures yet - it was raining last Sunday. I may take some next Sunday. I got a letter from Mildred yesterday. She said Bernice gave her my address.
