Dear Mama,

I didn't get your letter until late this afternoon. I don't always hear mail call and I think it layed in the Orderly Tent a day or two.

We don't have a very good system for mail here.

I went for a walk in the Park the 4th and took a few pictures. I meant ~~to~~ to finish the film last Sunday but it rained all day. It ~~has~~ rained all day today and is still raining tonight.

Whites and Blues had a physical examination today. They told me I had better have my teeth fixed before coming back next year.

Tomorrow is the last drill day. I think we have a parade. We were supposed to have parade today but it was called off because of rain.

We turn our uniforms in Wednesday and leave Thursday morning. I may not catch the local out of Chattanooga. If I don't I'll catch H. Howard Warts' brother is going to meet him in Oakdale so I will have a ride to Wartburg. I can catch a ride from there.

Not much news here and it's almost time for lights out so ~~so~~ I will close. I guess I'll be home the day after you get this letter so you won't have time to answer.
