Dear Mama,

Buster gave me your letter and the questionnaire yesterday afternoon. I am glad to hear that everything is alright.

I will let you know later what to do with the locker. Buster doesn't have a car so he couldn't bring it. I may wait until I can come home and then bring it back with me.

I get Friday off this week and Friday and Saturday next week. I don't get my check until the first tho - so don't guess I will get home.

I have plenty of work to keep me busy. I go to work at 11:30 AM and am supposed to get off at 8:30 - but I work until 9:30 and 10 most of the time.

I have to go to the Post Office this morning to get my questionnaire sworn to so I had better close pretty soon.

I am staying in a dormitory, rooming with
the boy from Wartburg I told you about.

I am flat broke now but I am
going to draw some script this morning
so you won't need to send me any money.
