Dear Dorothy,

I have just seen Buster this morning and he said you wanted me to write you. There isn't anything to write about except my work because that's all I do. We will have a recreation hall with a theatre & gym, later on, but I may not be here long enough to see it completed.

The new cafeteria is about completed. I think we ~~move in~~ ~~open~~ ~~it~~ up about the first of June. We will feed over 1000 men a day.

My boss told me they were getting in some girls for cashiers - and that I might have to work at night. I think if I stay here very long I will try for an apprentice electrician. I work 2 & 2 hrs. overtime everyday and don't get paid for it ~~because~~ because I am on an annual salary.

What are you doing now? I mean besides going to school. I believe Mama told me you weren't working in the caf. any more. When do you expect to be through school?

I never get to go to church here. I have to work every Sunday - but there's no church to go to any way. They are building a village here - so guess they will build a church too later on.

I am going home again next Thursday (21). Will just get to stay one night tho. Have to go to work Sat. morning.

Guess I had better close I have to go to work pretty soon.
