Sure was glad to hear from you and that you got back O.K. I was a little "blue" for a day or two after you & Alice left. I'm sorry that I couldn't see you off Mon. morning but I just couldn't make it. We were on the anti-aircraft range that morning.

By the way, I fired the sub-machine gun last week - it was some fun. That is the gun I am armed with in place of a rifle.

I ought to know something definite about a furlough by the last of the month. As it is I'm still in the dark.

Glad Jewell is better. I'll try to write her pretty soon.

Got a letter from John yesterday that he wrote on the 10th (Jan.) and was postmarked the 16. He didn't give any news except that he has moved to a new field. Also said he was getting along O.K. Hope everybody is well. Write
