Can't remember whether I owe you a letter or not. Haven't time to stop and figure it out so will just write. Hi! Sorta like Jewell huh?

They are really putting it to us this week. Third Corps inspection team here headed by Gen. Lucas (Com. O. III Corps). He asked several of us questions. Asked me how old I was, how long I had been in the army, and how long I had been Cpl. The rest of the week we are working out combat problems in the field - something like maneuvers.

Thanks for the Jol. papers - have been receiving them for several days. I read in the paper where you can't send publications oversea unless sent by the publisher. Thanks also for the sewing kit.



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Furloughs are supposed to be given
at pretty soon after this week. Maybe
I will be lucky and get one.

I heard from John last week - dated
around the middle of Jan. I believe.

Don't you and Dad work too hard or
worry too much.

I'm about to fall asleep so had
better close. Tell Caroline Hello & that
maybe I will write sometime.
