Dear Mama & all

I meant to write sooner but since I had written just before I recieved your last letter I put it off a while.

Everythings running about the same here. I haven't been quite as busy - at least I haven't been working at night.

I have found out that I will be here ten or eleven more weeks for unit training.

I was pretty certain of getting home something in March but am not so sure now. I may have to go to radio school for six wks. I'll let you know as soon as I find out.

Heard from Edwin B. today. He said Billy was ~~leaving~~ being inducted Mar. 1st. After seeing some of the boys they have here I have no doubt that they will take him.



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I am glad David got to come home again. Certainly would like to see him.

A Technician Sgt. is one grade ~~lower~~ lower than a "buck" sgt. although they both get the same pay.

Johnys' address is the same and he is still in England. I hope he is alright. They the bombers have been pretty busy over there the past two days.

I had a letter from Bill dated the 2nd of Feb. He seems to be getting along fine except for being a little homesick - V.
