Dear Dorothy,

Your letter came while I was - guess where home. Hi! In case you haven't heard from home Jewell is lots better. I suppose you have ~~already~~ heard from home since her trip to Nashville but thought I would tell you anyway.

I got an emergency furlough because of Jewell's operation and went to Nashville to see her. She was much better by the time I got there so as I had six days I went ~~on~~ home after spending one night and one day ~~there~~ with her.

Jewell received a letter from Johnny about the 15th of this month. It was dated Feb. 21. I think he got everything that was sent him Christmas.

We have several weeks of unit training left. We are spending all of next week in



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the field. I can't tell you where we are going. I'll tell you all about it when I get back. I hope its warmer by Monday. Its pretty cold right now.
