DEAR CAROLINE,

WELL AT LAST ~~WE~~ I HAVE GOTTEN AROUND
TO WRITING YOU A LETTER. WHAT DO YOU THINK
OF THAT? I WONT WRITE MUCH AS I DONT
HAVE MUCH TIME. I WAS OUT UNTIL 2:30AM
LAST NIGHT ON A ROAD RCN. I HAD TO GET UP
AT 5:30 AS USUAL SO YOU SEE I DIDN'T GET MUCH
SLEEP. WE GO OUT AGAIN TONIGHT ON A COMPASS
COURSE.

ARE YOU WORKING ALOT FOR MAMA THESE DAYS?
BE SURE AND DO THAT WILL YOU?

I WONT GET TO COME HOME WHEN I EXPECTED.
WE WILL BE IN THE FIELD NEXT WEEK. THAT IS WHY
MY FURLOUGH IS DELAYED. IT IS POSSIBLE I WONT GET ONE
UNTIL AFTER MANEUVERS. MAYBE BILL AND I CAN BE
HOME TOGETHER.
