I was very glad to get your letter. I always enjoy them very much. Don't sit up late at night just to write me though. I know how busy you are. Don't work too hard and get plenty of sleep. Tell Dad to do the same. He shouldn't be fighting fire. I know how hard that is.

Glad Alice liked the candy. Tell her to write and give me the school news.

I received the M. Co. papers - I always enjoy reading them. By the way did you get the ten I sent. You didn't mention it in your letter.

I won't be home Easter but I expect to be pretty soon after. I certainly would like to go to Sunbright with you.

We go in the field again Monday - for one week I think. We have had a cold snap here the past few days. Warming up a bit now. I heard from Billy last week. Tell Blanche not to worry about him. He's making it O.K.



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I had some more pictures taken this week. I haven't been to Evansville to see about the other ones yet. ~~I had the~~ We have a studio in camp now. I had them taken there. I should get them within two weeks.

Tomorrow is my last day in school. I suppose I will operate a set next week in the field. I passed 12 words per minute ^{test} today.

I am enclosing a picture I found in the Knoxville paper you might not have noticed. The two cars are scout cars - same as we have.

I only have 10 min. before bed check so I had better run. I'm writing this in the "Day Room" which we never use except at night. $\frac{1}{2}$
