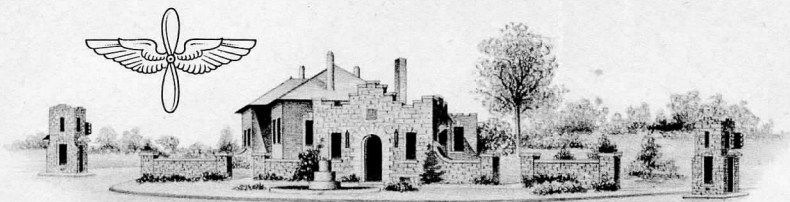
Dear Massa + all,
