Doesn't amount to much.

I heard from Bill the first of the week. He is O.K. but sure is in a lonely place.

I forgot to enclose that bond allotment receipt and don't have it with me at present ~~so~~ will send it later.

Does Dad have to pay any income tax? You will have to buy new ~~license~~ license for the car soon won't you? I won't get paid until about the seventh. Will try to send you more than I have been sending.
