I didn't realize it had been so long since I had written. Haven't been busy so I have no excuse.

Thought I was shipping out this morning but had my plans changed for me at the last moment. I have no idea when I will leave except that it is sure to be soon. Also - don't know where I will go. There is I think a fairly good chance of going overseas. I would like to go to England.

I understand that a ten day furlough is given before shipping out of the states. - over -



We aren't on any training program here. Usually we drill some, see training films and have physical training. I have every night off from 5:30 to 11:00 P.M.

I am going to a concert tonight—being presented in the Field House which is nearby.

Suppose you have been reading about the storms in Arkansas. We have had some pretty high winds but no twisters.

I think I will be here long enough to hear from you again if you write soon.
