I left Alice with Dot in Cincy last night about eleven thirty. Caught a 11:55 train for Ind - had a three hour wait there and arrived here at 8:40 this morning. Can't get out of here until 2:10 P.M. Don't know what time that will get me in Texarkana. It is a good thing I left ^{home} when I did tho. Don't have too much time to spare after all the layovers.

Evelyn didn't meet here folks in Danville. It might have been because the train was so late. We were held up so just this side of Winfield.
