There just isn't any news
here. I haven't been to Honolulu
for several weeks. There is no
point in going there anyway.

About the ^{old} Hawaiian music - that's
about all ^{that} the stations around here
broadcast. I tried of it the first
week.

We get a few re-broadcasts of state
programs - Bob Hope, Hit Parade, ect.
Also have plenty of news broadcasts.

Would like to know if you
have received any of my bonds.
You should get a \$25 bond per month
beginning with January.

Thanks for the subscription for the
journal - will let you know when
I get it. Also the Co. paper.

Notice that I have been assigned
a new APO (331). Hope everyone
is well. Tell Aunt Mary "hello."
