Dear Mama-

I'm still a civilian, but think I will be sworn in tomorrow. I never thought about being here this long without being assigned to some outfit or I would have written sooner. I still don't know what to put for return address - just wait before you write - I should get situated in the next day or two, and I'll drop a card.

Some draft boards sure are crazy - there are some men in here that can hardly walk. And they have to examine them. Just a waste of time I think.

Bernice and Dorothy came around to see me Sunday and I was gone over toward the open part of the Fort to see a ball game. They had only been gone about 15 min. when I got back. Bernice left a picture of the chorus she had clipped out of a paper.

I haven't written or called Dorothy, but I will as soon as I am located. I'm in temporary barracks right now.

I'll write more later.
