Dear Mama -

Well, I have finally been sworn in, but I still don't have my uniform and I have to take shots yet. I had to take another blood test after I got here - that delayed me a couple of days. I think I'll be straightened out now in the next day or so.

Some of the boys are getting furloughs, but they are supposed to have very important business to take care of - so I'm not asking for any.

About 7 or 8 Morgan Co. boys were rejected - you probably heard about that, - they are home by now.

I'll be here at least 4 days - maybe more so if you want to write my address is on the bottom.

I hope the chow is as good everywhere in the Army as it is here - I am gaining weight.

Hope everybody is O.K.
