Your letter came today - I won't write much tonight because it's too late now. I wrote Bessie a short note anyway and got a pretty complete coverage of the current news in it - something very easily done, considering the circumstances. I'll just say thanks for the news for this time and write you again soon.

My hunch was right, wasn't it? About Russell. What is his APO number? I met some fellows from the Hawaiian Islands on my return from furlough, one of whom was from Tennessee.

Jewell's idea of you taking a rest every afternoon is an excellent one. But do you have to write letters? Can't you just plain rest? And make it a daily affair?
