Dear Mom -

Received your letter today that you wrote from Nashville. You said you hoped there was a letter from me waiting for you when you returned. I'm afraid you've already been disappointed - so I was determined to answer to-night.

Glad you were able to attend the graduation ceremony. Jewell sent me one of the announcement cards. Tell her I'm sorry I was unable to send a gift. I haven't even written her yet. Dorothy hasn't written in a good while - and I'm almost sure I wrote her last. I suppose she's doing OK.

So Russell and Johnny are both on the move again. One of the boys in Johnny's outfit who has a brother in my outfit -

buddy is Larry De Ore, and his
brother, James De Ore, sleeps just
across from me) The last time he
wrote ~~John~~ Jim he said Johnny
was going to Casablanca. Your
