Dear Mama—

Here's another "letter of transmittal" — as it would be called in the army. Transmitting some more pictures.

Weather up here is getting colder every day. When the freeze-up comes it really freezes, ocean and all. And boats can't come in anymore until the ice "breaks" about the 1st of July. When we landed here on 29th of June we dodged big ice floes for several miles. The rumors are that we'll spend the winter in Nome. We will at least be afforded the comforts of steam heated barracks there. It's pretty definite we'll get out of here before the end of October.
